



GORBA Privacy Policy

The Guelph Off-Road Bicycling Association Ltd. (GORBA) respects the privacy of our members' personal information and is committed to compliance with Canada's privacy laws.

Personal information is collected, used, and disclosed only for the following purposes:

- To establish and maintain your membership
- To communicate GORBA events and information to you
- To facilitate communication between GORBA members

Your personal information will be used only for the purposes listed above unless proper consent is received from you.

The GORBA Membership Application contains statements of express consent. You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting GORBA's Privacy Officer.

GORBA may collect, use, or disclose personal information without your knowledge or consent in exceptional circumstances where such collection, use or disclosure is required by law.

GORBA will keep your personal information only as long as necessary for the identified purposes for which it was collected.

To ensure compliance with Canada's privacy laws, GORBA's Secretary also acts as our Privacy Officer who will establish and maintain GORBA's personal information collection, use and disclosure policies and procedures. GORBA's Privacy Officer is available to answer your privacy related questions and will investigate and determine any privacy related complaints filed in writing. When you make a request in writing to the GORBA Privacy Officer, GORBA will within a reasonable time tell you what personal information GORBA has on file.
